



## 2. Village Pond Rejuvenation in Vasad, Gujarat

## **Date: August 19, 2023**

In line with the Mission Amrit Sarovar launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, SERI undertook a project to rejuvenate the village pond in Vasad, Anand district, Gujarat. This initiative aimed to improve water quality for agriculture and livestock, thus enhancing food security and providing a recreational space for the community.














### **Key Activities:**

- Landscaping and Infrastructure: Leveling and concreting the pond area, creation of stone pathways, installation of light poles, and drainage systems.
- **Environmental Enhancements:** Plantation of green vegetation, including beneficial and medicinal shrubs and trees.
- Recreational Facilities: Creation of a cricket ground and boundary fencing for public use.

The rejuvenation efforts included cleaning the water body, strengthening the side walls with stones, and installing seating benches. These improvements have significantly boosted the local agricultural productivity and community well-being.





## 3. Hillnet Distribution to Prevent Vector-Borne Diseases

Locations: Alipurduar (West Bengal), Patna (Bihar), Nalanda (Bihar), Balasore (Odisha)

**Total Distributed: 50,000+ Mosquito Nets** 

Public health initiative carried out by the Socio Economic Research Institute (SERI) aimed at reducing the spread of vector-borne diseases, specifically malaria and dengue, in certain high-risk areas.













## **Key Points Explained:**

#### 1. Initiative Overview:

 SERI launched a major campaign to distribute over 50,000 "Hillnets," which are special types of mosquito nets, to various communities.  The regions chosen for this distribution were Alipurduar in West Bengal, Patna and Nalanda in Bihar, and Balasore in Odisha. These areas were identified as being at high risk for diseases like malaria and dengue.

#### 2. Purpose of Hillnets:

 Hillnets are designed to provide strong protection against mosquito bites, which are the primary means of transmission for diseases like malaria and dengue. The nets are an important tool in preventing these diseases.

#### 3. Target Population:

The campaign focused on rural and tribal populations in these regions. These groups are considered to be at higher risk because they often have limited access to healthcare services, making them more vulnerable to the effects of these diseases.

#### 4. Health Impact:

 By distributing these mosquito nets, SERI's goal was to significantly lower the number of malaria and dengue cases in the targeted areas. This would lead to better overall health and wellbeing for the affected communities.













## 4. Vitamin A Capsule Distribution in Jahangirpuri, Delhi

Date: December 10, 2023

SERI conducted a significant health initiative in the slum areas of Jahangirpuri, Delhi, distributing Vitamin A capsules to 1500 individuals to combat nutritional deficiencies. This effort aimed to enhance health outcomes, particularly for children, by addressing critical nutrient gaps.



## **Key Activities:**

• **Distribution:** 1500 Vitamin A capsules

• Target Audience: Residents of Jahangirpuri, particularly children

• Health Benefits: Improved vision, immune function, and overall growth

SERI also focused on health education, engaging with recipients to discuss the importance of Vitamin A and ways to incorporate it into daily diets. This educational component was vital in ensuring the sustained impact of the initiative.

## 5. Safe Drinking Water in Rural Odisha

**Date: October 21, 2023** 

With support from our international partner SEVA CHILD, SERI facilitated the installation of submersible bore wells in various villages of Nabarangpur district, Odisha. This project provided access to safe drinking water for backward, underprivileged, and marginalized populations.





#### **Key Activities:**

- **Infrastructure Development:** Digging submersible bore wells
- Target Areas: Backward and marginalized villages in Nabarangpur district
- **Health Impact:** Improved water quality, reduced disease incidence, and enhanced hygiene practices

Access to safe drinking water has had a profound impact on the health and well-being of these rural communities, aligning with the UN's recognition of water and sanitation as fundamental human rights

# 6. <u>Free Health Care and Awareness Programme through Free Distribution of Personal Hygiene Kits and Sanitary Napkins</u>

**Date:** March 8, 2023 **Location:** Nalanda, Bihar

**Target Group:** Women and adolescent girls **Beneficiaries:** 1,200 Women and Girls

On International Women's Day, March 8, 2023, SERI organized a comprehensive health care and awareness event titled *Free Health Care and Awareness Programme through Free Distribution of Personal Hygiene Kits and Sanitary Napkins* in Nalanda, Bihar. The program was designed to address the critical issue of menstrual hygiene management (MHM) in rural areas, where access to sanitary products is often limited due to economic constraints and social stigma.





The event commenced with a series of educational sessions that focused on the importance of menstrual hygiene, breaking taboos associated with menstruation, and promoting health and well-being among women and girls. Expert health professionals conducted these sessions, providing accurate information and answering questions from the participants.



Following the awareness sessions, SERI distributed personal hygiene kits, which included sanitary napkins, soap, hand sanitizers, and other essential hygiene products, to approximately 1,200 women and girls. This initiative was not only about providing products but also about empowering women with knowledge and confidence to manage their menstrual health with dignity.



The event received an overwhelmingly positive response from the community, with many participants expressing their gratitude for the resources and information provided. SERI plans to replicate and expand this initiative in other regions to continue addressing menstrual hygiene challenges and promoting women's health.

## 7. Street Light Installation in Village Areas of Balasore

Date: May 2023

Location: Village Areas of Balasore, Odisha

**Target Group:** Rural communities **Installations:** 250+ Street Lights

In May 2023, SERI undertook a significant infrastructure project aimed at enhancing the safety and quality of life in rural areas of Balasore, Odisha. The installation of over 250 street lights across various villages was a crucial step towards creating a safer and more secure environment for the residents.



The lack of adequate street lighting in rural areas often leads to increased risks of accidents, crimes, and other safety concerns, particularly after dark. Recognizing this need, SERI coordinated with local authorities and community leaders to identify key areas where street lighting would have the most impact.

The installation process was carried out with precision, ensuring that the lights were strategically placed to cover maximum areas, including roads, public spaces, and near schools and health centers. The street lights installed are energy-efficient, utilizing LED technology to reduce energy consumption and ensure long-term sustainability.



The impact of this project has been profound. Residents have reported a marked reduction in night-time accidents and a greater sense of security when moving around their villages after dark. This initiative aligns with SERI's commitment to improving rural infrastructure and enhancing the overall living conditions in underserved areas.

## 8. Installation of Smart Classes in Government Schools of Anand District

Date: July 2023

**Location:** Anand District, Gujarat

Target Group: Students from Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Scheduled Castes (SC)

Beneficiaries: Economically Weaker Section Students

In July 2023, SERI made a significant investment in the future of education by installing smart classes in government schools across Anand district, Gujarat. This initiative was specifically targeted towards schools with a high population of students from Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Scheduled Castes (SC), many of whom come from economically weaker sections.





The smart classes are equipped with modern educational technology, including interactive whiteboards, projectors, and access to digital learning resources. These tools are designed to enhance the learning experience, making education more engaging and accessible for students who have traditionally faced barriers to quality education.

The introduction of smart classes represents a transformative shift in the way education is delivered in these schools. Teachers have been trained to effectively use the new technology, integrating it into their lesson plans to create dynamic and interactive learning environments. Students, who previously had limited access to digital resources, are now able to explore a wealth of information and learning materials that were previously beyond their reach.





The impact of this initiative has been immediate and significant. Students have shown increased enthusiasm for learning, and teachers have reported improvements in academic performance and engagement. By bridging the digital divide, SERI is helping to level the playing field for students from marginalized communities, giving them the tools and opportunities they need to succeed in today's increasingly digital world.

## 9. Installation of Hand Pumps in Patliputra Village Area

Date: March 2024

**Location:** Patliputra, Bihar **Target Group:** Rural households **Installations:** 30 Hand Pumps

Access to safe and clean drinking water is a fundamental necessity, and in August 2023, SERI took a significant step towards ensuring this for the residents of Patliputra village in Bihar. The installation of 30 hand pumps was

carried out to address the chronic water shortages and the challenges faced by the community in accessing potable water.



Prior to this intervention, many households in Patliputra relied on distant water sources, which were not only inconvenient but also posed risks of contamination. Women and children often had to travel long distances to fetch water, which was both time-consuming and physically demanding.

SERI's intervention focused on installing hand pumps in strategic locations throughout the village, ensuring that every household had easy access to clean and safe drinking water. The hand pumps were installed using high-quality materials to ensure durability and longevity. Regular maintenance protocols were also established, with local community members being trained to handle basic repairs and upkeep.



The installation of these hand pumps has brought about a dramatic improvement in the quality of life for the residents of Patliputra. The availability of clean water has reduced the incidence of waterborne diseases, lessened the daily burden on women and children, and contributed to better overall health and well-being in the community. This initiative is a testament to SERI's commitment to addressing essential needs and improving living conditions in rural areas.

# 10. <u>Hydraulic and Pneumatic Lab Setup in Government Polytechnic College, Singrauli</u>

Date: September 2023

Location: Government Polytechnic College, Singrauli, Madhya Pradesh

**Target Group:** Polytechnic Mechanical Students

**Beneficiaries:** 200+ Students

In a significant step towards promoting sustainable livelihood opportunities and enhancing vocational education, the Socio Economic Research Institute (SERI) established a state-of-the-art Skill Development Technical Lab at Government Polytechnic College, Singrauli, Madhya Pradesh. This initiative received an NOC on October 2, 2023, and aims to provide reskilling and upskilling opportunities to marginalized youth, focusing on creating sustainable employment pathways.



#### **Key Features:**

- Facilities: The lab is equipped with one set of Pneumatic Trainer Kit and one set of Hydraulic Trainer Kit, along with advanced hydraulic and pneumatic systems, including pumps, valves, actuators, and control systems.
- **Target Audience:** Educated but unemployed young individuals from marginalized sections and polytechnic mechanical students.
- **Beneficiaries:** Over 200 students from the Polytechnic Mechanical department.
- **Objective:** To enhance technical skills, bridge the gap between academic learning and industry requirements, and provide sustainable employment opportunities.

The lab also includes simulation software and training modules that help students understand the theoretical concepts behind hydraulic and pneumatic technologies. This hands-on training and practical experience have already positively impacted the students, increasing their confidence and technical proficiency.

This initiative is part of SERI's broader goal to promote economic independence and improve the socio-economic conditions of the youth in Singrauli, contributing to the overall development of the region.



The lab is also expected to attract more students to the polytechnic college, as it offers a unique opportunity for hands-on learning that is not available in many other institutions. This project underscores SERI's commitment to fostering technical education and preparing the next generation of skilled professionals in India.

# 11. <u>Distribution of Ration Kits to Marginalized Communities in Cuddalore</u> <u>District</u>

Date: November 2023

Location: Cuddalore District, Tamil Nadu

**Target Group:** Marginalized and vulnerable families

**Beneficiaries:** 200+ Families

In November 2023, under the provisions of the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA), SERI conducted a large-scale distribution of ration kits to marginalized and vulnerable families in Cuddalore district, Tamil Nadu. This initiative was part of our ongoing efforts to provide essential support to communities facing economic hardship and food insecurity.





The ration kits distributed included essential food items such as rice, lentils, cooking oil, sugar, salt, and other staples, sufficient to meet the nutritional needs of a family for a month. Each kit was carefully curated to ensure that it provided balanced nutrition, taking into consideration the dietary needs of the recipients.

The distribution process was meticulously planned and executed, with priority given to the most vulnerable families, including those headed by women, elderly individuals, and persons with disabilities. Local volunteers and community leaders were involved in the identification of beneficiaries and the distribution process, ensuring transparency and fairness.

The impact of this initiative has been profound, providing much-needed relief to families struggling to meet their daily needs. The distribution of ration kits has not only helped to alleviate hunger but has also contributed to the overall well-being and resilience of these communities. SERI is committed to continuing such interventions to support those most in need and to promote food security and social welfare.


